

**Dooly County Elementary School  
Standardized Uniform Dress Code  
(Effective 2008-09 School Year)**

<b>TOP</b>	<b>BOTTOM</b>
<i>White, Gold/Yellow, Blue or Red</i>	<i>Khaki or Navy Blue</i>
Solid color Collared shirt (polo/golf type or oxford) Short or long sleeves A small unobtrusive logo is acceptable. (One that can be covered with a quarter.)	Solid color Slacks, shorts, skirts, capris, dresses, or jumpers
<b>BELT</b>	<b>SHOES</b>
<i>Black, brown, tan or navy</i>	<i>Any color</i>
Solid color Buckles no larger than 2 inches	Tennis shoes preferred. No flip-flops or bedroom shoes allowed. 2 inch heel limit
<b>EXCEPTIONS</b>	<b>OTHER ITEMS NOT ALLOWED</b>
The school administration may designate special spirit days during the year. Earrings are allowed.	Wind pants, sweatpants, velour pants, over-sized clothing, unhemmed clothing, clothing with cuts or slashes, denim or jean fabric, sleeveless shirts, overcoats, trench coats, cargo-type pants with numerous side pockets, hats, sweatbands, sunglasses, or facial jewelry.
Pupils are expected to be clean and appropriately dressed for school. Dress and appearance must not present health or safety problems or cause disruption and should encourage a serious approach to school. The school administration will be the final authority for determining appropriate dress within the framework of the Standardized Uniform Dress Code.	

1. **PANTS:** Must be secured at the waist. Pants cannot be “sagging.” No banding at the hem allowed.
2. **TOPS:** All shirts must be tucked in. Skin may not show. Undershirts must be solid in color with no wording or pictures.
3. **LENGTH:** Shorts, skirts, dresses, skorts, and jumpers must meet the fingertip rule. All hemlines must be longer than the tips of the fingertips when arms are placed down the sides of the body.
4. **OUTERWEAR:** Jackets, coats, sweaters, cardigans, and sweatshirts are considered outerwear and must be worn with a uniform shirt. All outwear must be of a solid color.
5. **T-SHIRTS:** Students may wear school T-shirts on field trips or spirit days at the discretion of the school administration.
6. **TRANSFERS:** Students who transfer from other school districts will be given five (5) days to comply with the dress code.
